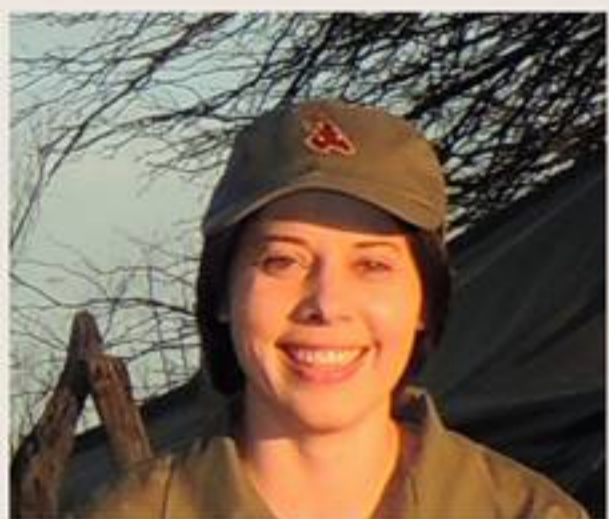

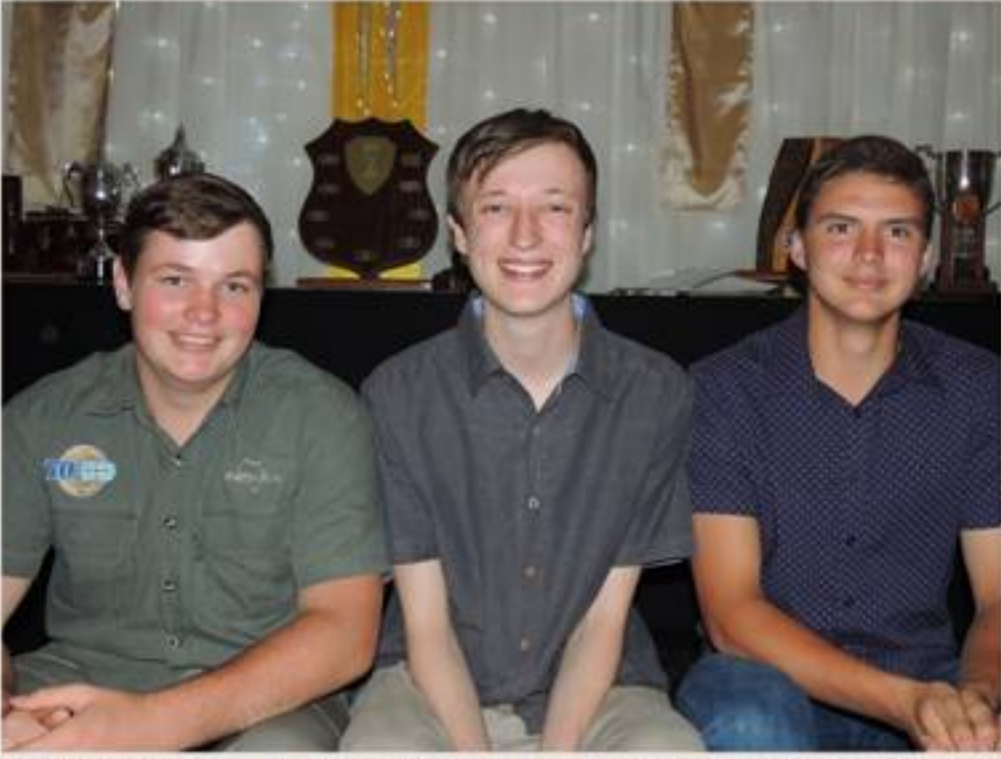

Reminder to our members

Prohibited hunting methods and instruments

9. (1) Without limiting the meaning of the word "hunt", no person may, unless he or she is the holder of a permit and subject to the conditions set out in the permit, hunt a wild animal

(p) by means of darting or a device which injects an intoxicating or a narcotic agent or poison into such animal,

(q) which is kept in captivity, confined to a cage, in an enclosure or trapped against a fence where it does not have a fair chance of evading the hunter

(r) which is under the influence of a tranquilizing or narcotic immobilizing or similar agent

(s) by the use of a dog, except for hunting, flushing, pointing or retrieving of birds, or for the purpose of searching or following the animal which has been wounded

(t) in the case of a bird, in or upon any aquatic system, by the use of a boat for the purpose of chasing or killing the bird

(u) by means of setting a set trap, set gun, poison firing apparatus or snare within 10 meters from a common boundary

(v) by luring or by means of simulation or recording of the natural sound made by an animal or by means of bait or scent or any induced learning method

(w) in an area smaller than the set standard of 400 hectares

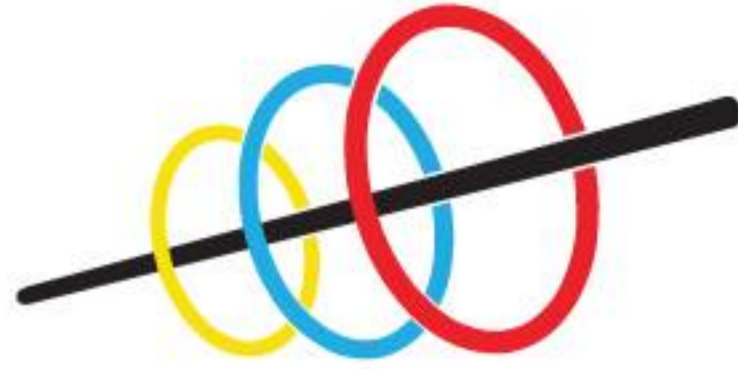
(x) by any other device of which the use could result in injuring or killing an animal in a way which is not an acceptable humane hunting method

BOOGJAG vanaf verhoogde skuilings

Met die jagseisoen om die draai kry sommige van ons al ons toerusting gereed en lê ons in die aande en dink hoe ons 'n uitstekende skootplasing sou neem om suksesvol te kan wees. Daar is verskillende jagmetodes en -tegnieke en ons wil onself goed toerus en voorberei vir die uitdaging. Met boogjag kan mens besluit om gebruik te maak van metodes soos uit 'n boogskietskuiling; loop-en-bekruip en boomstoele. Sommige boogskietskuilings is verhewe en mens skiet na onder net soos by boomstoele.

Meeste van ons jagters weet dat wanneer mens na onder skiet, of na bo, dit sal veroorsaak dat die pyl die teiken hoog tref.

Die rede daarvoor is die verkeerde afstand-bepaling.

Dit kan gebeur vanaf verhoogde boogskietskuilings of boomstoele of selfs vanaf 'n koppie of krans.

Verhoogde boogskietskuilings en boomstoele in Suid-Afrika is gewoonlik nie so hoog soos die metodes wat gebruik word in byvoorbeeld Amerika nie. Die volgende voorbeeld kan ter verduideliking gebruik word: Kom ons sê die jagter is in 'n hoë boogskietskuiling of boomstoel.

Die afstand van die teiken is 15 jaart vanaf die basis van die skuiling of boom (in die geval van 'n boomstoel). Gestel die jagter bevind hom op 'n hoogte van 20 jaart. Dan sal die afstand vanaf die skietposisie tot by die teiken 17.8 jaart wees. Met die gebruik van 'n afstandsmeter ("rangefinder") sal dit 18 jaart lees, behalwe as die "rangefinder" die funksies het om na onder of na bo te kan lees.

Die afstand wat die jagter hier moet gebruik om te korrel is 15 jaart.

Dit is veral belangrik om dit in ag te neem wanneer die jagter spesies jag wat snaarspringers is. By groter spesies op naby afstande sal dit nie so vreeslik saak maak nie, aangesien die skootplasing groter is. Dit is aan te beveel om gereeld te oefen vanaf verskillende hoogtes, om sodoende jouself fisies en sielkundig voor te berei. Wanneer die skut in 'n staande posisie na onder korrel moet hy sy liggaam by die heup sywaarts na onder buig (tilt) en nie net regop staan en sy arm by die skouer afbuig nie. Hou altyd in gedagte om veiligheid in ag te neem veral wanneer boogskietstoele gebruik word. 'n Harnas is handig, maar moet korrek aangewend word - anders breek jy dalk iets met die val uit die boom; of (uit 'n Noordkaap-boom) val jy dalk jou wind uit! Geniet die voorbereiding en laat die pyle reguit vlieg!
