## 2. Family Group Photograph

These photographs should portray any family groups of wild animals/birds in their natural environment. Again, zoo ohotographs will not qualify.

## 3. Hunter and his Quarry Photograph

This certificate will be awarded to the person who has submitted the entry. It is not a prerequisite that he/she should appear in the photograph.

## 4. Landscape Photograph

Any landscape photograph within the African context eg. sunsets, sunrises, windmills, trees, moon, mountains, etc.

## 5. Miscellaneous

Any other photographs not covered by above categories - can be humerous or funny.

The competition is open to all NCHA members. Cost per entry will be R5 per photograph. Maximum size is A5.

Number of entries per person/category is limited to 5 . All photographs will be displayed for everybody to view. It is requested that photographs entered are to be on display till after the Year-end Function in the evening. The NCHA will do its utmost to safeguard the photographs during this period. However the association cannot be held responsible for any loss or damage thereof. Photographs will be listed as per entry number and available for collection at the office on Monday.

A panel appointed by the committee will judge the photographs. Certificates will be presented at the Year-end Function, which is to be held at Horseshoe Inn. The judge's decision is final.

## 4.PREVIOUS MINUTES

## 5. MATTERS ARISING

a. The move of the NCHA shooting range from Marrick farm was finalized and a new home was found at Amakulu Safaris on the Boshoff Road. Wildman Gun Shop is the booking and usage connection.
b. The Hartebees and The Hartie: COVID had caused sporadic delivery of the Hartie. Members
were asked to be patient if certain matters needed thought and consultation before a standpoint could be offered. It was agreed thar the associations communications should be in English and Afrikaans
c. Association Firearms. Nothing to report. Adequately maintained by D Jacobs
d. Website: Certain glitches were rectified and members were encouraged to refer to the buy and sell facility on the website
e. GWK Sponsorship: for members Re guns and associated products was still available. A membership card was needed at purchases.
f. CHASA Sport Shooting: This department safely in the hands of the Vaalharts branch and under the stewardship of Clayton activities were picking up.
g. Endorsements: certain associations e.g. Suid Kaap had issues RE this matter. NCHA has all under control.
h. Firearm Laws: Messages and reminders in this regard were passed on to the members, mostly by WhatsApp. However, the responsibility of Firearm ownership rested wholly and solely with the owner thereof.
i. Vultures: Some progress was taking place with the Vulture project. Common sense interaction was bringing the various parties closer to each other and a greater understanding was evolving especially regarding the blame of hunting for the decline of numbers of vultures.

e.C Hall told the meeting that the data route of membership could damage the association's individuality.
