Northern Cape Hunters' Portal

It is indeed a great pleasure to introduce the Northern Cape Hunters' Portal to our members. As everyone is aware times are changing and for the Association to stay relevant and in sink with the latest developments and trends in the industry, it is important to adapt to the environment in which we need to operate to be able to participate in the sport and culture which we all cherish.

We need to be able to provide our members with the ability to comply with the minimum requirements for owning firearms for different applications such as hunting, dedicated hunting, and dedicated sport shooting.

Members will be able to obtain all relevant documentation prescribed by the Firearms Control Act for firearm licensing, renewals, dedicated hunters' examinations as well as dedicated sport shooting records and results once they have registered and completed all relevant categories on the Hunters Portal.

The benefit that each member will obtain from the Nunters Portal will depend on the completeness and accuracy of information which you will voluntarily capture in the system. For instance – if you capture the details of all firearms owned by you including the caliber, issue and expiry dates of licenses and intended use and motivations. Hunters' Portal will inform you of looming renewals and expiry dates and the required endorsements for the firearm will be approved and obtainable from the system. The necessary support staff in the form of the Northern Cape Hunters' Management Team with their allocated portfolios will attend to submissions and approvals submitted on the system. Furthermore, our Secretary, Madelaine, is available during working hours for queries and questions as the personalized service that we provide will never be compromised.

Endorsements will for instance be applied for and approved online based on the accuracy of information provided by you, where after you can print the documentation, membership letters of good standing, membership cards and even records for compliance in the case of sport shooting activities.

This will of course be done within the framework of legislation prescribed by the Firearms Control Act, 2000, the South African Protection of Personal Information Act, 2013 as amended ("POPI). You will also agree to the Terms of Conditions for using the Hunters Portal.

We trust that you will support and embrace this initiative and technology and that it will enable us to provide you with the ability to comply with the least amount of effort required for maintaining your compliance for owning a firearm to participate in hunting, sport shooting and your dedicated status for such where it is required.

Instructions on how to access the Hunters Portal will be sent via WhatsApp in due course.
